The instant petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of the India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the official respondents No.2 and 3 to take appropriate legal action against the respondents No.4 and 5 who are trying and making an attempt to forcibly take away the vehicle of the petitioner bearing Registration No.PB-05AB-9078 with the help of recovery agents, as such conduct of the respondents No.4 and 5 is against the notification dated 28.09.2006 (Annexure P-1) issued by the Reserve Bank of India as well as in violation of various judgments of the Hon'ble Supreme Court.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the instant petition with liberty to take recourse to the alternative and efficacious remedies available to him in accordance with law.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty as aforesaid.
