This is a petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ of mandamus directing the respondents to reimburse the amount of medical expenses to the tune of Rs.2,05,748/- incurred by the petitioner from 30.06.2017 to 11.07.2017 on the treatment of his ailing wife suffering from Adhesive Bowel Obstruction as an indoor patient alongwith interest @ 18% per annum.

Learned counsel for the respondents has pointed out that the bill of the medical treatment claimed in the petition has already been reimbursed to the petitioner. Even this fact is not disputed by the learned counsel for the petitioner.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
