This second petition is filed seeking regular bail in case of FIR No.6, dated 19th January, 2020, under Section 22 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Khuian Sarwar, District Fazilka.

Affidavit filed on behalf of the State is taken on record. Copy supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned State counsel on the basis of affidavit submits that the prosecution evidence has been completed.

One of the main grounds for seeking bail is the custody period along with the fact that trial is not proceeding at a decent pace.

Learned counsel for the petitioner in view of the affidavit filed is not pressing the petition at this stage.

Dismissed.

However, there is no doubt that in case a request is made before the Court concerned for accommodating dates for an expeditious disposal of the trial, the same would be considered in accordance with law.
