This is a petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ of mandamus directing the respondents to grant the pay band of Rs.5200-20200+1900/- grade pay as per appointment letter (Annexure P-1) along with all consequential benefits from the date of appointment; along with certain other prayers.

Notice of motion was issued and the learned counsel for the respondents has filed additional affidavit dated 27.09.2022 in Court today, which is taken on record, stating therein that the pay scale claimed by the petitioner in this writ petition has been granted to him.
