Case heard by video conferencing.

Vide CRM-M No.34610 of 2020, the petitioners seek quashing of
FIR No.421, dated 27.09.2020 registered at Police Station Civil Lines Hisar,
alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under Sections 147,
149, 323, 506 IPC, as also all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom,

on the basis of a compromise (copy Annexure P-2), arrived at between them and respondents no.2 to 6.

Vide CRM-M No.34530-2020, the petitioners therein, who are respondents no.2 to 6 in CRM-M-34610-2020, seek quashing of FIR No.371, registered at the same police station, on 02.09.2020, also alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under Sections 147, 149, 323, 506 IPC, again on the basis of the compromise reached between the parties.

It is to be noticed that the complainant in FIR No.371 (respondent No.2 in CRM-M-34530-2020) is stated to have died after the petition was filed on 27.10. 2020. He is stated to have passed away on 17.12.2020.

Consequently, vide an order dated 09.12.2021, this Court had directed that the statements of Class I legal heirs be recorded in terms of the compromise stated to have been reached between them(during his life time).

Pursuant to that order, the report of the learned JMIC, Hisar, dated 04.01.2022, has been received, stating to the effect that the wife of the late Sh. Sanjay Singh, i.e. Manisha Singh, and his sons Amrit Singh and Arjun Singh (petitioners in CRM-M-34610-2020), appeared before that Court on 04.01.2022 and stated that the matter has been compromised between the parties amicably of their own free will, with them having confirmed the factum of the death of Sh. Sanjay Singh on 17.12.2020.

They further stated before the Court that the compromise between the parties has been reached during the life time of Sh. Sanjay Singh and that they do not wish to pursue the criminal proceedings.

Petitioners No.1 and 2 in CRM-M-34530-2020 (respondents No.2 and 3 in CRM-M-34610-2020) also appeared before that Court and made

similar statements.

The statements have also been annexed along with the report of the JMIC, Hissar.

That being so, also looking at the nature of offences involved, with the matter having been amicably settled between the parties, CRM-M No.34610 of 2020 FIR No.421, dated 27.09.2020, registered at Police Station Civil Line Hisar, District Hisar, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under Sections 147, 149, 323, 506 IPC, as also CRM-M No.34530-2020, FIR No.371, registered at the same police station, on 02.09.2020, also alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under Sections 147, 149, 323, 506 IPC, along with all the proceedings emanating therefrom, are hereby quashed.

A copy of this order be placed on the file of the connected case.
