1. Learned Sr. Advocate, assisted by Mr. J.S. Randhawa, Advocate, states that in view of copy of reply having been supplied to him by learned counsel for the respondents, it has come to his notice that the petitioner has not been paid pension as per her entitlement ever since January, 2001 i.e. the date of adoption of her deceased husband's daughter from previous wife.
