Petitioner prays for an anticipatory bail under Section 438 of Cr.P.C. in FIR No.212 dated 02.08.2021, under Sections 353, 186, 148, 149, 379 and 506 of the IPC, registered at Police Station City Muktsar, District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

Vide order dated 23.09.2021 passed by a Coordinate Bench, *ad interim* anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the aforesaid order dated 23.09.2021, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Jagdish, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and she is not required for any further investigation.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 23.09.2021 granting *ad interim* anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions envisaged in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
