Petition herein, *inter alia*, is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus for directing the respondent – Commission to award marks for question No.13 of Paper Code “H” to petitioner No.1 and likewise marks of question No.55 of Paper Code “C” be awarded to petitioner No.2 in the written examination for the post of Clerk against Advertisement No.05/2019 dated 20.06.2019 category No.1 (Annexure P-1). They claim that they have been wrongly assessed despite correct answers given by them qua the said questions.

2. On advance service, learned State counsel appears and submits that a decision will be taken by a competent authority, either way, by passing a speaking order if the petitioners move representation in this regard.

3. At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioners also seeks decision on the representation to be moved, as suggested by learned State counsel.

4. Given the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to seek return by any of the respondents as no further proceedings and/or pleadings are required.

5. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the instant writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents that in case any such representation is moved by the petitioners within 7 days, the same shall be decided by passing a speaking order therein within 30 days thereafter.

6. Pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
