ANOOP CHITKARA J. (ORAL)

Vide order dated 29.01.2020, this Court had granted interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the matter was compromised for one time settlement for Rs.75 lacs. On different dates, an amount of Rs.55.5 lacs stands paid. He seeks eight weeks time to make the outstanding amount.

3. Learned counsel for the private respondent does not dispute this fact.

3. Given the nature of allegations, no pre-trial incarceration is required. Without commenting on the case's merits and the circumstances peculiar to this case, the petitioner makes a case for release on bail.

5. Given above, the present petition is allowed. The order dated 29.1.2020, is hereby made absolute.

6. It is clarified that final opportunity is afforded to the petitioner to make the outstanding amount. If the petitioner fails to make the payment, it shall be open to the complainant to file cancellation of bail only on this ground alone.
