The instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, praying for enhancing the quantum of compensation in judgment dated 13.05.2022 in case titled as “State Vs. Lakhwinder Singh @ Lucky and another.”

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner states that the compensation amount of Rs.7 lacs as awarded to the minor victim has been pursuant to order passed by the trial Court and that the petitioner has not approached the District Legal Services Authority for compensation in terms of the provisions of Compensation Scheme for Women Victims/Survivors of Sexual Assault/other Crimes, 2018. He seeks permission to withdraw the present petition so as to have recourse to the remedy available to the petitioner in the form of approaching the concerned District Legal Services Authority for award of compensation as per the said Scheme.
