Present application has been filed for preponing the date of hearing of the main petition i.e. CWP No. 17854 of 2022, which stands adjourned to 15.09.2022.

Notice of the application to the counsel opposite.

Mr. Harish Nain, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State and raises no objection for the grant of prayer as raised in the present application.

Keeping in view the above, application is allowed and the hearing of the main petition i.e. CWP No. 17854 of 2022 is preponed from 15.09.2022 to today.

CWP No. 17854 of 2022

Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that petitioner was posted at the present place of posting only in January, 2022 vide order dated 05.01.2022 (Annexure P-11), therefore, as the petitioner has not even completed the minimum required period at District Jhajjar, he is wrongly being forced to participate in the transfer drive. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the said grievance has already raised the said grievance in the application dated 05.08.2022 (Annexure P-13) before the authorities concerned and they will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the concerned authorities to decide the said plea of the petitioners.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Harish Nain, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and states that he has instructions to submit that the application filed by the petitioner dated 05.08.2022 (Annexure P-13) will be decided within a period of seven days from today and the transfer order if any, issued in the meanwhile, will only be implemented after the passing of the order on his application.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
