By this common order, the writ petitions, details of which have been given above, are being disposed of as both the writ petitions involve the same question of law on similar facts.

Learned counsel for the petitioner(s) submits that the petitioners are working as Class-IV employees with the respondents and are

entitled for regularization of their services.

As per the respondents, certain employees, who are juniors to the petitioners, have been regularized and without considering the claim of the petitioners, they have been extended the benefit of regularization. The respondents have given the details of the juniors and their seniority number so as to claim the benefit that even against the available post, on the basis of seniority, the petitioners were entitled for regularization of their services.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that the claim of the petitioners for regularization of their services will be considered in accordance with law under the Policy issued, according to which, the part time employees were entitled for regularization of their services and in case, any of the junior of the petitioners has already been regularized, the benefit of regularization of service will also be extended to the petitioners with effect from the said date and appropriate order upon the consideration of the claim of the petitioners will be passed within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order by the department concerned.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present petitions may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

Ordered accordingly.
