The instant petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of the India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents No.2 and 3 to not to implicate the petitioner in FIRs No.8 and 9 under Sections 7, 7(A) and 8 of P.C. Act, 1988 (Amended) Act, 2018 and Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at Police Station Vigilance Bureau, Flying Squad, S.A.S. Nagar, Mohali (Annexures P-5 and P-6).

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the instant petition with liberty to take recourse to the alternative and efficacious remedies available to him in accordance with law.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty as aforesaid.
