The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of orders dated 01.07.2022; 26.07.2022 and 06.08.2022 (Annexures P-2, P-3 & P-6, respectively), passed by the learned Additional District & Sessions Judge, Jalandhar in a case bearing CIS No. NDPS-188-2021 in FIR No.246 dated 11.12.2020 under Sections 21 (C), 29, 61, 85 of the NDPS Act, Section 25 of the Arms Act and Sections 201, 212, 216 of the Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station Lohian, District Jalandhar, whereby, the bail bonds of the petitioner have been cancelled and non-bailable warrants against the petitioner have been issued due to his non-appearance on 01.07.2022.

In view of the averments made in the petition, particularly in para No.5, wherein, it has been stated that the petitioner was granted regular bail and, thereafter, the case was fixed for hearing on 01.06.2022 and the petitioner noted down the next date of hearing as 21.07.2022 instead of 01.07.2022 and when the petitioner came to the Court on 21.07.2022, he could not find the case in the cause list and he immediately contacted his counsel, who on inquiry, informed that vide order dated 01.07.2022, his bail bonds/surety bonds were cancelled and non-bailable warrants were issued against him for 26.07.2022.

The petitioner is directed to appear before the Trial Court on 25.08.2022 and furnish his bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court. Upon doing so, the learned trial Court is directed to release the petitioner on bail to its satisfaction.

The present petition stands disposed off.
