VINOD S. BHARDWAJ. J.

The instant petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for seeking issuance of appropriate writ, order or direction in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to grant compensation on account of death of deceased Satish Kumar due to electrocution.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners contends that the deceased Satish Kumar had gone to visit his fields on 20.07.2019 where he was electrocuted due to High Tension Wires hanging loose. He submits that an FIR No.145 dated 27.08.2019, under Section 304-A of the Indian Penal Code, was registered at Police Station, Ismailabad, District Kurukshetra, in this regard. He further submits that a legal notice was also sent by the petitioners on 30.06.2020 to the respondents – UHBVNL seeking compensation on account of death of deceased Satish Kumar due to electrocution.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondents – UHBVNL has referred to the reply filed on behalf of the respondents and has submitted that the respondents – UHBVNL, has already passed a speaking order on 17.02.2022 rejecting the claim of the petitioners.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners thus prays for withdrawal of the present petition with liberty to file appropriate petition on the same cause of action impugning the order dated 17.02.2022 so passed by the respondents authorities in accordance with law.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
