Learned counsel for Union of India-respondent No.1 submits that the petitioner has to apply on a new format for grant of licence of prohibited.303 bore rifle. Despite issuance of letter dated 29.03.2017 (Annexure R-1/3) by the Department of Home Affairs and Justice, Government of Punjab advising the petitioner to fill new proforma prescribed under the new Arms Rules, the petitioner has not fulfilled the said requirement so far.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he

would advise his client to submit his application form under the new format prescribed under the new Arms Rules, 2022.

In case, such a new application under the prescribed format is submitted by the petitioner to the competent authority, the same shall be processed preferably within a period of two months.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
