The petitioner has filed the instant petition with a prayer to direct the respondents No.1 to 5 to protect the lives and liberty of the petitioner from the hands of private respondents No.6 to 10.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already submitted a representation dated 18.10.2021 (Annexure P-1) to the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sri Muktsar Sahib and he shall be satisfied if directions are issued to respondent No.3 to look into their representation dated 18.10.2021 (Annexure P-1).

In view of the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner and without expressing anything on the merits and claim of the parties, respondent No.3- The Senior Superintendent of Police, Sri Muktsar Sahib is directed to depute a senior officer to look into the matter and after seeking a report, he may pass an appropriate orders on the representation (Annexure P-1), in accordance with law.

With these observations, this petition is disposed of.
