HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is not pressing his claim in respect of impugned order dated 27.07.2016 (Annexure P-7) at this stage, vide which order, claim of the petitioner for the grant of LTC amount, while he was in service, was declined by the respondents on the ground that the said benefit is applied after the retirement.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner is entitled for the grant of LTC or its lump sum amount once in four years, and now the petitioner has already been retired since the year 2013, but he has not been extended the said benefit, even after the expiry of eight years from his retirement.

Learned State counsel submits that in case the petitioner has any grievance with regard to the grant of LTC after his retirement, the

petitioner may approach the respondents by filing an appropriate

representation in this regard, and in case any such representation is filed by the petitioner, the same will be considered in accordance with law and an appropriate speaking order will be passed by the authorities concerned within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of the copy of such representation.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the submissions of learned State counsel, as recorded hereinbefore, no further grievance of the petitioner survives in the present petition at this stage and the same may kindly be disposed of as having been not pressed any further with liberty to the petitioner to approach the respondents by filing an appropriate representation, claiming LTC for the period after his retirement.

Ordered accordingly.
