The petitioners are seeking a direction to the respondents for granting them promotion as per Service Rules of 2014.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that during the pendency of the petition, petitioner No.1 has been given requisite relief as the petitioner No.1 has been promoted to the post of Prabandhak. Petitioner No.2 is similarly situated. He is at serial number 3 in the seniority list while Narinder and Naresh Kumar, who were at serial No.6 and 7, have been promoted. He also submits that the case of petitioner No.2 for promotion has been recommended by the Society in its meeting held on 30.10.2014 (Annexure P-5) subject to the verification of his B.A. degree. He also contends that Services Rules of 2014 are applicable.

Learned State counsel submits that verification of petitioner No.2's BA degree is to be done by the employer and in the reply filed by the respondents it is stated that no resolution has been passed. It is also submitted in the reply that employer where the petitioner No.2 is working has not been impleaded.

Heard.

The petition qua petitioner No.1 has been rendered infructuous as he has been granted the requisite relief and stands disposed of as such.

The case of petitioner No.2 for promotion appears to have been recommended by the Society subject to the verification of his degree (Annexure P-5). Two of the persons, who are junior to petitioner No.2, have also been promoted. Petitioner No.2 is entitled to be considered for promotion from the date his juniors have been promoted.

In view of the above, the petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to consider the case of petitioner No.2 for promotion in accordance with Rules subject to verification of his B.A. degree and resolution passed by the respondents within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Civil Miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
