Prayer in the petition is for issuance of directions to the official respondent No.2 to conduct a fair and impartial investigation on the complaint dated 16.03.2021 filed by the petitioner against respondents No.5 and 6.

Reply by way of affidavit of DSP, Sub-Division, Sunam, District Sangrur has been filed, which is taken on record. As per the reply on receiving the complaint, an enquiry was conducted by the DSP and the petitioner was called many times to come forward and join the enquiry proceedings, however, he failed to join the investigation. After verifying the contents of the complaint, it was found that respondent No.6 was working as a domestic help in the house and the petitioner was known to her and he wanted to get married. Later on, they performed marriage on 30.09.2020 in a Gurudwara, however, after 3 months, they parted away and started living separately. The enquiry concluded that there is no cheating with the petitioner and the complaint has been given just because the respondent No.6 has withdrawn from the matrimonial home. Accordingly, no further action is called for.

The petition is disposed of.
