The present petition was filed by the petitioners under Sections 482 Cr.PC for quashing of FIR No.106 dated 19.08.2020 under Sections 326, 324, 323, 452, 148 and 149 IPC, Police Station Qadian, District Batala, alongwith all consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 02.09.2021 (Annexure P-2) effected between the parties.

Pursuant to the order dated 24.09.2021, the report of the learned SDJM, Batala, dated 07.01.2022, has been received.

Heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the report of the Court below.

A perusal of the report at Flag-A reveals that the learned SDJM, Batala after recording statements of the parties, has in her report dated 07.01.2022 concluded that “the Court is satisfied that the compromise effected between them is found to be a valid compromise and

has been effected without there being any kind of influence or coercion.”

In view of the compromise there is a remote possibility of the complainant coming forward to support the prosecution case. The powers under Section 482 Cr.PC can be exercised in such like situation in order to prevent unnecessary vagaries of criminal trial to be faced by the parties, when there are remote chances of conviction of the accused. The compromise in question is found to be fully in consonance with the direction issued by the Court in *Kulwinder Singh & Ors. Vs. State of Punjab* 2007(3) RCR (Criminal) 1052 and *Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab & Anr.*, 2012(4) RCR (Crl.) 543.

In view of the aforesaid report accompanied by statements of both the parties, the FIR in question and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.

Petition stands disposed of.
