1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P/1 reveals that while issuing notice of motion in CWP-20829-2021, same interim relief was granted, as in CWP-13386-2021.

3. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states in view of the needful having been done in pursuance of order Annexure P/1 and the petitioner being allowed to perform duty, the petitioner does not press the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
