Mr. Kiran Pal Singh, AAG., Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and does not raise any objection to the withdrawal of this writ petition.

At request and with consent of learned counsel for the parties, hearing of this writ petition is preponed from 13.05.2022 for today itself.

This writ petition has been filed for quashing of Communication dated 07.02.2019, Annexure P-10, wherein approval granted by respondent no.2 for promotion of respondent no.6 as Head Clerk has been granted and for quashing of promotion order dated 14.09.2021, promoting respondent no.6 as Head Clerk/Deputy Superintendent and further prayer to consider the petitioner's case for promotion to the post of Head Clerk/Deputy Superintendent from the date when respondent no.6 was promoted along with other ancillary prayers.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of the preliminary objection about the alternate statutory remedy available to the petitioner before the Education Tribunal, petitioner seeks to withdraw this writ petition with liberty to avail the said remedy and take all available pleas before the Education Tribunal.

Keeping in view the above, CM-806-CWP of 2022 is allowed and CWP No. 18276 of 2020, is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforementioned.
