VIKAS BAHL, J. (ORAL)

This is the first petition for the grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.136 dated 17.07.2018, registered under Sections 302, 341, 506 and 34 IPC and Sections 25/27/54/59 of the Arms Act, at Police Station Lopoke, District Amritsar Rural.

Learned Senior counsel for the petitioner has submitted that out of total 23 witnesses, the complainant has been examined and examination-in-chief of the alleged eye witness Pargat Singh has been done, but he has not been cross-examined.

Learned Senior counsel for the petitioner, after arguing for some time, seeks permission of this Court to withdraw the present

petition, at this stage, with liberty to file a fresh petition after the material witnesses are examined.

In view of the statement made by learned Senior counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn, as prayed for, with liberty to file a fresh petition after the material witnesses have been examined.

It is made clear that the second petition for regular bail, if any filed by the petitioner, would be considered independently, on its merit, in accordance with law.
