Vide this petition, the petitioner seeks issuance of a writ in the nature of *certiorari* quashing/setting aside the impugned order dated 17.08.2020 (Annexure P-17) passed by respondent no.7, whereby her claim for allotment of a house to bonafide residents of a notified colony has been denied, without considering the facts of her application dated 06.02.2018, Annexure P-7 (as alleged).

On 14.12.2021 the following order had been passed by this court:-

“Counsel for the petitioner seeks a date to place on record relevant material/documents to demonstrate eligibility of the petitioner under the Chandigarh Small Flats Scheme 2006 (as amended from time to time).

List on 27.01.2022.”

Thereafter on 27.01.2022 counsel for the petitioner had sought further time to place on record relevant material to show that she was actually Jaswant Kaur widow of Madan Lal @ Rajesh Kumar, which has still not been done.

Learned counsel seeks permission to withdraw this petition and file a fresh one on the same cause of action.

We find absolutely no ground to grant such liberty and consequently this petition is dismissed.
