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**RAVI SHANKER JHA, C.J. (Oral)**

The petitioner has challenged clause 1.1.1 (iii) of the e-tender notice (Annexure P-13) issued by the official respondents.

Learned Senior Standing Counsel appearing for the Union Territory, Chandigarh, on instructions from Mr. C.B. Ojha, Chief Engineer, U.T., Chandigarh, submits that the respondent-authorities have withdrawn clause 1.1.1 (iii) of the e-tender notice and, therefore, the grievance of the petitioner is redressed and the petition is rendered infructuous. It is further submitted that the successful tenderer, who was allotted the tender in question, has also completed the work.

To this, learned Senior counsel for the petitioner submits that let the petition be disposed of as infructuous in terms of the statement made by Mr. Anil Mehta, but he may be granted liberty to approach this Court in case any cause of action survives or arises.

The petition is, accordingly, disposed of as infructuous with the liberty prayed for. Application(s), if any, also stands disposed of.
