Challenge in the present petition is to the assessment order dated 24.12.2018 (Annexure P-3). A writ of mandamus is also prayed for directing the 1st respondent to release a refund of Rs. 11,77,000/- along with applicable interest under the relevant provisions of the Income Tax Act.

An alternate prayer has been raised in the petition that the appeal preferred by the petitioner against the assessment order dated 24.12.2018 (Annexure P-4) be decided in a time bound manner.

Since an advance copy of the petition already stood served upon the respondents, Mr. Vivek Sethi, Senior Standing Counsel has entered appearance on behalf of the respondents.

Counsel for the respondents makes a statement that the appeal
