[1] Prayer in the instant petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1 dated 12.05.2022 in CWP-10049-2022.

[2] A perusal of order Annexure P-1 reveals that CWP-10049-2022 was disposed of by directing the respondent herein to consider and decide the representation in accordance with law within two months from the date of receipt of the same from the petitioner.

[3] Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent has filed compliance report-cum-reply alongwith receipt issued by the petitioner in acknowledgement of having received Rs.455439/- vide cheque No.566920 in terms of order No.C/16 dated 04.04.2022 passed by the commissioner, MC, Amritsar and mentioning therein of nothing remaining due. Copy of compliance report is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner who on perusal

petitioner, he does not press the instant petition but prays for grant of liberty to move an application for claiming outstanding payment, if found due, on reconciliation.

[4] In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
