This petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing FIR No.75, dated 17.04.2016, under Sections 306 of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Sadar Dhuri, District Sangrur and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of the compromise dated 11.09.2021 (Annexure P-2).
