1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 02.05.2022 in CWP-9100-2022.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P-1 dated 02.05.2022, reveals that CWP-9100-2022, was disposed of by directing the respondent to decide representation dated 16.03.2022, filed by the petitioner within two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and to communicate the decision to the petitioner and in case of failure to do so, the officer responsible would pay costs of Rs.20,000/- to the petitioner.

3. Although notice has not been issued in the instant case, yet, the respondent has passed order dated 18.08.2022, rejecting the claim of the petitioner.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of order dated 18.08.2022, having been passed by the respondent, rejecting the claim of the petitioner, the petitioner does not press the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same with liberty to challenge order

dated 18.08.2022, by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.

5. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
