Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Through this petition, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.70 dated 24.09.2019, registered at Police Station Talwara, District Hoshiarpur, under Sections 452, 307, 427, 148, 149 and 120-B IPC (subsequently Section 307 IPC has been deleted).

Vide order dated 24.09.2021 passed by this Court, *ad interim* anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the aforesaid order dated 24.09.2021, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Gurinderjit Singh, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for any further investigation.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 24.09.2021 granting *ad interim* anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
