HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was removed from the post of Peon while working with respondent No.2-College on the ground that the petitioner was not qualified enough to hold the post of Peon keeping in view the rules governing the service according to which, a Peon was required to have passed middle class examination whereas, the petitioner does not have the said qualification.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that though the petitioner has taken time to rebut the said contention to show the eligibility that she has passed middle class examination but as the petitioner has not been able to contact the learned counsel, the said fact could not be controverted.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner be given liberty to approach the respondents by producing her qualification that she was fully eligible to hold the post of Peon and the respondents be directed to decide the said claim afresh, in case the petitioner proves her eligibility under the rules.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case, the petitioner approaches the authorities concerned with the proof that she was having the required qualification for the post of Peon, appropriate consideration will be given to the said claim and appropriate order will be passed within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of any such claim.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the above said statement of the learned State counsel, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further, with liberty as prayed for.

Ordered accordingly.
