Learned counsel for the petitioners argues that against the order imposing the recovery dated 02.07.2018 (Annexure P-1), passed against the late father of the petitioners an appeal was preferred by the late father of the petitioner, a copy which has been appended as Annexure P-3 dated 27.10.2018, but the said appeal has not been decided by the authority concerned, which is causing prejudice to the petitioners as, the recovery in pursuance to the impugned order dated 02.07.2018 (Annexure P-1), is now sought to be recovered from the petitioner being legal heir of late Om Parkash.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the Appellate authority to decide the Appeal dated 27.10.2018 (Annexure P-3) by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Nain, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Learned counsel for the respondents raises no objection in deciding the Appeal dated 27.10.2018 (Annexure P-3) of the petitioners in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioners for the relief which has been claimed by them in the appeal dated 27.10.2018 (Annexure P-3), the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the appeal dated 27.10.2018 (Annexure P-3) within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order, if not already decided.
