The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 105 dated 31.08.2021, registered under Section 306 and 34 of the IPC at Police Station Nehianwala, Bathinda.

The operative part of the order dated 06.10.2021, vide which the petitioner has been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“Learned counsel for the petitioners, at the very outset, submits that Kuldeep Kaur wife of deceased Chiragdin has surrendered before the police authorities and has joined the investigation. It is further submitted that allegations against petitioner Jagseer Singh @ Seera, who is brother of Kuldeep Kaur as well as petitioner Ranjeet Singh, father of Kuldeep Kaur, are not specific. It is also submitted that there is no specific allegation in the suicide note.

Learned State counsel has filed short reply by way of affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Bhuchu, Bathinda, District Bathinda in the Court today and has not disputed the factual position.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in pursuance to the order dated 06.10.2021, has already appeared before the SHO/Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Parkash Singh, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 06.10.2021, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
