In the present writ petition, the grievance of the petitioner is that though, the petitioner is working on contract basis with the respondents but the salary, for which, the petitioner is entitled for has not been released to him by the respondents on the ground that extension of the petitioner in service is still under consideration.

Learned Senior counsel for the petitioner submits that once the petitioner is performing duties with the respondents, he is entitled for salary on regular basis so as to survive and live a dignified life as envisaged under Article 21 of the Constitution of India.

Learned Senior counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance before the respondents by way of filing a representation dated 08.07.2022 (Annexure P/9), which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondent No.3 to

decide the said representation.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Nain, AAG, Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondents and raises no objection in deciding the representation dated 08.07.2022 (Annexure P/9) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

In view of the request made, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner in his representation, respondent No.3 is directed to decide the representation dated 08.07.2022 (Annexure P/9) by passing a speaking order within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order. In case after the decision, it is found that petitioner is entitled for any relief, the same will be extended to him within a period of next four weeks.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
