Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail in case having FIR No.239, dated 10.05.2022 registered under Sections 420, 409 and 120-B IPC at Police Station Sector 27, Sonipat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of previous order, the amount of Rs.3,39,636/- stands already deposited by the petitioner. He further submits that petitioner has joined the investigation with the police, in the light of the order of interim bail passed by this Court.

The State counsel on instructions from ASI Suresh Kumar apprised the Court that petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required by the police for any further investigation.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 22.08.2022 is hereby made absolute. However, the petitioner should abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
