On 10.04.2019, it was stated on behalf of the appellants by learned counsel for the appellants vide separate statement recorded on that date that the appellants would be satisfied if another sum of ₹1,33,744/- over and above the amount already awarded by the MACT concerned is granted to them in full and final settlement of the claim in the present appeal. Thereafter, matter was being adjourned for concurrence of respondent No.3 – Union of India.

Today, learned counsel for respondent No.3 – Union of India along with Major Deepshika has come present and has stated that Union of India has agreed to the aforesaid proposal of the appellants and even cheque for the amount of ₹1,33,744/- was issued 2-3 times and however, the same could not be encashed by the appellants due to COVID restrictions and the validity of the last cheque has also expired.

However, in view of the fact that the respondent – Union of India has agreed to the proposal of the appellant, the present appeal is disposed of by awarding ₹1,33,744/-.

It has further been stated by learned counsel and representative of respondent No.3 – Union of India that as the cheque was not being encashed by the appellants, the amount of ₹1,33,744/- has been transferred

in the account of the appellant – Sunehari Devi by way of RTGS. Statement of learned counsel and representative of the respondent – Union of India has also been recorded to this effect. It has also been stated today by learned counsel for the appellants that the amount of ₹1,33,744/- has since been credited in the account of the appellant – Sunehari Devi and that hence, the present appeal be disposed of as such as no further action is required in this case. Statement of learned counsel for the appellants has also been recorded separately to this effect.

Accordingly, the present appeal stands disposed of.

Copy of the order be given to learned counsel for the parties, who are present today and file be returned to the Hon'ble High Court.
