This order shall dispose of aforesaid two petitions filed on behalf of Preeti Shriwas and Raj Kumar Shriwas respectively, seeking grant of anticipatory bail in respect of a case registered against them vide FIR No.463 dated 01.12.2020 at Police Station Ladwa, District Kurukshetra, under Sections 420/467/468 & 471 IPC.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioners has informed that the parties have amicably resolved their issues and that as per the compromise effected amongst them before the Mediation & Conciliation Centre attached to

this Court on 16.08.2022, he has brought a demand draft of Rs.5.50 lakhs favouring the complainant. While original demand draft has been handed over to Ms. Divya Sharma, learned counsel representing the complainant, a photocopy of the same has been taken on record.

3. Learned counsel representing the complainant has endorsed the factum of compromise and has submitted that the complainant does not have any objection in case the petitioners are granted anticipatory bail.
4. Learned State counsel has feigned ignorance about the factum of compromise, but has informed that pursuant to interim directions issued by this Court, both the petitioners have since joined investigation and are not required for any custodial interrogation.
5. Having regard to the aforestated position, wherein the petitioners had already joined investigation and the matter is otherwise stated to be amicably resolved amongst the parties, the petitions are accepted and the interim directions issued by this Court vide order/s dated 17.02.2021 in CRM-M-7622-2021 and 01.10.2021 in CRM-M-40485-2021 are hereby made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioner shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so and cooperate with the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
