This petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of writ in the nature of *habeas corpus* by directing respondents No.1 to 4 to produce minor daughter of petitioner, namely, Kaisha Arora, aged about 03 years 01 month. It has been alleged that she has been illegally removed from the custody of the

petitioner on 18.07.2022 by respondents No.5 to 8 and since then even her whereabouts are not known to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner as well as counsel for respondent No.5 submit that there are good chances of compromise between the parties and, therefore, counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition.

He further submits that the order dated 11.10.2022, vide which the petitioner/mother was given visiting rights to meet the child, may be modified to the extent that the petitioner and respondent No.5 shall mutually fix the place and time on every Saturday for meeting the child- Kaisha Arora.

Keeping in view of the sensitivity involved in the matter and to maintain harmony between the parties, this Court grants permission to do so in their interest, as requested.

With the consent of the parties and the above said observations, the present petition stands disposed off accordingly.
