Due to COVID-19 situation, the Court is convened through video-conference.

This petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C seeking for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.15 dated 26.01.2017 under Sections 302, 120-B read with Section 34 IPC of 1860, registered at police station Nehianwala, District Bathinda.

One of the main grounds for seeking bail is the custody period.

The counsel for the state on instruction submits that out of twenty seven prosecution witnesses, twenty six have been examined. The next date is fixed for 31.01.2022. He submits that earnest effort would be made to conclude the prosecution evidence by 21.02.2022.

In view of the statement made by the counsel for the State, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw the present petition at this stage.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

There is no doubt that in case a request is made before the trial court for accommodating dates for an early conclusion of the trial, the same would be dealt in accordance with law.
