[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1, dated 20.03.2019 in CWP No.7709 of 2019.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 reveals that CWP No.7709 of 2019 was disposed of by directing the Registrar, Punjabi University, Patiala to examine the claim of the petitioners against the backdrop of the legal notice dated 22.05.2018 expeditiously and in any case within two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

[3] Learned counsel for the respondent has produced copy of speaking order dated 22.05.2020 deciding the claim of the petitioners as contained in legal notice dated 22.05.2018. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioners who on perusal thereof states that in view of the needful having been done, he does not press the instant petition but prays for grant of liberty to the petitioners to take out appropriate proceedings in accordance with law for seeking interest on the delayed release of payment.

[4] In view of the position noted above as well as the statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, the contempt petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
