Writ petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to grant the benefit of Contribution Pension Scheme dated 12.12.2006 to petitioners from the date of their appointment and to deposit the necessary amount along with interest in their account(s).

At the outset, learned counsel on instructions from petitioners submits that substantial prayer is accepted by respondents, however, claim regarding interest is still pending. Therefore, he does not press the petition at this stage.

Disposed off accordingly.

It is made clear that in case, the grievance still subsists, the petitioners would be at liberty to raise their plea before the competent authority concerned within four weeks from today and the same shall be

considered in accordance with law within next eight weeks positively.
