Counsel for the appellant submits that he has no instructions. Even otherwise in the present Letters Patent Appeal the dispute is regarding the answer key as to whether the questions as such were correct or incorrect.

The learned Single Judge has relied upon the judgment of the Apex Court passed in **Ranvijay Singh Vs. State of Uttar Pradesh, (2018) 2 SCC 357** to held that it is not for this Court to interfere in the correctness of the answer keys. It has been noticed that reliance as such to contend that the answer key were wrong was on the basis of material downloaded from the Google. It has also been noticed that the objections were invited and the writ petitioner did submit his objections and that the Expert Committee after considering the objections had rejected the same. The view has been reiterated by the Apex Court in **Bihar Staff Selection Commission & others Vs. Arun Kumar & others, 2020 (2) SCT 609**.

In such circumstances, we are of the considered opinion that the learned Single Judge did not err in any manner in declining to interfere in the correctness of the answer keys. Accordingly, there is no merit in the present appeal and the same is dismissed.
