Learned counsel for the petitioners argues that though in the present petition, the challenge is to the order dated 13.06.2015/15.06.2015 (Annexures P-15 and P-16) terminating the services of the petitioners but during the pendency of the present petition, the petitioners have been reinstated in service.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the only grievance which survives now in the present petition is that the petitioners, who are physically handicapped, are allowed to continue in service for which, the petitioners intend to approach the respondents by filing appropriate representation and the direction be given to the respondents to decide the said representation in accordance with law by passing an appropriate speaking order as expeditiously as possible.

Learned State counsel submits that in case, any grievance is raised by the petitioners by filing any representation, the same will be considered in accordance with law and appropriate order will be passed within a period of two months from the receipt of the same.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement of the learned State counsel, no further grievance of the petitioner survives in the present petition and the same may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further, with liberty as prayed for.

Ordered accordingly.
