The petitioners have filed the instant petition with a prayer to direct the respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the lives and liberty of the petitioners from the hands of private respondents No.4 and 5.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have already submitted a representation dated 12.08.2022 (Annexure P-5) to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran and he shall be satisfied if directions are issued to respondent No.2 to look into their representation dated 12.08.2022 (Annexure P-5).

In view of the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioners and without expressing anything on the merits and claim of the parties, respondent No.2- The Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran is directed to depute a senior officer to look into the matter and after seeking a report, he may pass appropriate orders, in accordance with law.

This order shall not be construed as an expression/opinion on the validity of the marriage of the parties. The parties mentioned in the petition or any other person mentioned in the petition shall be at liberty to

take recourse to appropriate law, if any.

With these observations, this petition is disposed of.
