The instant application has been filed under Section 151 of the Civil Procedure Code, seeking preponement of the date of hearing in the main case.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner does not press the instant application.

Dismissed as not pressed.

Main case

The present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondent – Haryana State Pharmacy Council to grant registration to the students who have passed qualified course from the petitioner - University.

Learned counsel for the petitioner - University contends that petitioner - University has established a school of pharmacy which offers Degree in B.Pharmacy and D.Pharmacy Allopathic Courses. She contends that the respondent – Haryana State Pharmacy Council, however, is not responding to the applications submitted for registration as Pharmacist by the students who have completed the requisite Courses from the petitioner - University and a notice dated 21.08.2021 (Annexure P-3) has already been served on respondent - Haryana State Pharmacy Council in this regard. She contends that she would be satisfied in case the Haryana State Pharmacy Council is directed to look into the notice dated 21.08.2021 (Annexure P-3) and to pass a reasoned and speaking order thereupon in a time bound manner.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent – the Haryana State Pharmacy Council, has no objection to the aforesaid prayer being accepted.

Resultantly, with the consent of the parties and without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent – the Haryana State Pharmacy Council, to pass a reasoned and a speaking order on the notice dated

21.08.2011 (Annexure P-3) appended with the instant writ petition thereupon after affording an opportunity of hearing to the respective parties within a period of three months of the receipt of certified copy of this order after affording an opportunity of hearing to the respective parties.

Disposed of accordingly in above terms.
