Power of Attorney on behalf of the appellant has been filed today, which is taken on the record.

As agreed, as per statements of the appellant, learned counsel for the appellant and learned counsel for the Insurance Company (separately recorded), a sum of ₹20,000/- (₹ Twenty Thousand Only) over and above the amount awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the appellant in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit a crossed-cheque for ₹20,000/- in the name of the appellant - Subhash son of Ram Narain with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 23.11.2022, in compliance of this order, failing which, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount from the date of this order till payment. The concerned Officer of the Lok Adalat Branch/Office shall issue proper receipt after receiving the cheque to learned counsel/representative of the respondent – Insurance Company. The appellant(s)' counsel/appellant(s) may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat.
