[1] Mr. I.S. Sidhu, learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent No.4 states that he has already filed compliance report-cum-reply and copy thereof has been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.

[2] Learned counsel for the petitioner on the other hand states that Annexure P-1 dated 14.03.2018 in CWP No.6292 of 2018, violation of which is complained of in the instant petition has been complied with by passing speaking order (Annexure R-1) dated 31.10.2022, therefore, in the circumstances, he does not press the instant petition but prays for grant of liberty to the petitioner to challenge order (Annexure R-1) dated 31.10.2022 by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.

[3] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
