Learned counsel for the petitioners argues that in the present writ petition, the grievance of the petitioners is that they have been forced to participate in general transfer drive by the respondents whereas, the petitioners cannot be forced to do so on the ground that they have not completed five years of service at their present place of posting and therefore, keeping in view the directions issued by this Court in **CWP-15108-2021** titled as **Vikram Singh and others. State of Haryana and others** decided on 24.08.2021 and as the writ petition filed by the petitioners was also disposed off in the same terms, the petitioners cannot be forced to participate in the general transfer drive for effecting transfers for the session-2022-23.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners will approach the respondents by way of filing an appropriate representation making out the case that they be excluded from the general transfer drive and their case be considered in accordance with law especially in view the order passed by this Court in the case of **Vikram Singh (supra)**.

Mr. Harish Jain, AAG, Haryana, who is appearing on behalf of the respondent-State keeping in view the service of advance copy of the petition submits that in case any representation raising the said grievance is filed by the petitioners with the respondents, the same will be decided by the respondents within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of the said representation.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement made by learned State counsel, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed off having been not pressed any further with liberty as prayed for.

Ordered accordingly.
