Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the claim of the petitioner in the present petition is that the petitioner is working on the post of Sub Divisional Engineer and keeping in view the order dated 19.08.2009 (Annexure P-3), according to the petitioner, he is entitled for the grant of pay scale of ₹15600-₹39100 along with grade pay of ₹6000/- and the grant of the said relief has also been recommended by the department for a favourable consideration to the Additional Chief Secretary, Govt. of Haryana, Public Works (B&R), Department, Chandigarh vide letter dated 07.05.2015, but no action has been taken by the respondents on the said recommendation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner

will be satisfied in case, a time bound direction is given to the respondents

to take appropriate decision in pursuance to the said letter and in case, thereafter the petitioner is found eligible for the grant of relief, the same be extended to him.

Learned State counsel submits that in case, no decision is taken by the Government so far in regard to letter dated 07.05.2015, appropriate decision will be taken within a period of eight weeks and after the said decision, in case the petitioner is found eligible for any relief, he will also be considered for the grant of same within a period of next four weeks.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the above, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

Ordered accordingly.
